ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A21 GLA ROAD (RUSHEY GREEN, LONDON BOROUGH OF LEWISHAM) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2022

- Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- The purpose of the Order is to enable signal modernisation works to take place on the A21 Rushey Green.
- The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
 entering or proceeding in a southerly direction on A21 Rushey Green
 - between its junctions with Brownhill Road and Sangley Road;
 (2) stopping on Rushey Green eastern kerb line between its junctions
 - with Brownhill Road and Sangley Road.

 The Order will be effective at certain times between 7:00 AM on 3rd January 2023 and 7:00 PM on 17th May 2023 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be
- indicated by traffic signs.

 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police
 - constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.

 At such times as the prohibitions are in force an alternative route will be
- At such times as the prohibitions are in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via Brownhill Road, Plassy Road and Sangley Road to normal route of travel.
