LONDON BOROUGH OF LEWISHAM Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 The Lewisham (Foxberry Road, Howson Road and Kneller Road, SE4) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2023

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lewisham Council made the above named temporary traffic order under the provisions of section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 because of works on and adjacent to the highway. The effects of the order are indicated below.

- 1. (1) Road closure and no parking/waiting on (i) Foxberry Road, between the southwestern kerbline of Coulgate Street and the western kerbline of Howson Road; (ii) Howson Road, between the southern kerbline of Foxberry Road and the southern kerbline of Kneller Road; and (iii) Kneller Road, between the western kerbline of Howson Road and the projected common boundary of Nos. 10 and 12 Kneller Road. (2) The diversion routes for traffic affected by the prohibition shall be via (i) Foxberry Road, Coulgate Street, Brockley Road and Foxberry Road; (ii) Harcourt Road, Brockley Road and Foxberry Road; and (iii) Foxberry Road, Brockley Road,
- Brockley Hoad and Foxperry Hoad; and (III) Poxperry Hoad, Brockley Hoad, Braxfield Road, Howson Road, Kneller Road.

 2. Exemption is provided in the order for vehicles engaged on the works, vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes and
- vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes and anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer.

 3. The order comes into force on the 27th February 2023 to remain in
 - force for up to 6 months. (Note: Works are planned to be carried out in three phases to ensure not all the roads are closed simultaneously.)

 4. The prohibitions apply as, when and to the extent signed on the
- highway.
