- 2. The general nature and effect of the Orders will be to:
  - 1) formalise the change of the operational hours of the Parking and Disabled Persons Vehicles Bay outside Nos. 116 to 122 New Cross Road to 'No Stopping Mon-Sat 7am - 7pm Except 10am-7pm parking I hour No return within 2 hours'
  - 2) reintroduce a 27 metre Parking and Disabled Persons Vehicles Bay opposite Nos. 17 to 23 London Road operating 'No Stopping Mon – Sat 7am - 7pm Except 7am - 4pm parking I hour No return within 2
- hours' 3. The roads which would be affected by the Orders are the A2 New Cross Road in the London Borough of Lewisham and the A24 London Road in the London Borough of Merton.
