TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – SOUTHBANK SPINE ROUTE

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable Public Realm improvement works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, in agreement with the Transport for London, have made an Order, the effect of
- which will be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering:

 (a) that section of Belvedere Road, which lies between
 the north-eastern kerb-line of Chicheley Street and
 the south-western end of Lipper Ground:
 - the south-western end of Upper Ground;
 (b) Concert Hall Approach, the whole length;
 (c) the south-east bound slip road between Upper
 - Ground and Waterloo Bridge, the whole length;
 (d) the north-west bound slip road between Belvedere
 - (d) the north-west bound slip road between Belvedere Road and Waterloo Bridge, the whole length; and
 (e) that section of Upper Ground, which lies between
 - north-eastern end of Belvedere Road and the boundary of The London Borough of Southwark (adjacent to the western kerb-line of the north to south arm of Barge House Street).

Alternative routes for affected vehicles will be provided

- via (i) Belvedere Road, South East Bound Slip Road between Upper Ground and Waterloo Road, Waterloo Road roundabout; and (ii) Belvedere Road, Chicheley Street, York Road.

 3. The ban will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

 4. The Order will come into force on 18 th June 2023 and will continue for a maximum duration of 18 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been
