ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A3036 GLA SIDE ROAD (BLACK PRINCE ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2023

- I. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable excavation works to repair damage duct to take place on Black Prince Road.
- 3. The effects of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
 - (1) Proceeding in the westerly direction on Black Prince Road between its junctions with Albert Embankment and Vauxhall Walk:
 - (2) Entering and proceeding on the Albert Embankment service road fronting Nos.9 to 23 Albert Embankment between its junction with Black Prince Road and the southern boundary of No.9 Albert Embankment.

5th June 2023, every day from 7:00 AM until 7:00 PM or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

The Order will be effective at certain times between 4th June 2023 and

- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- 5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via Vauxhall Walk, Tinworth Street and Albert Embankment to normal route of travel.
