## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A3214 GLA ROAD (BUCKINGHAM PALACE ROAD, CITY OF WESTMINSTER) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) (No.4) ORDER 2023

- I. Transport for London in consultation with the City of Westminster hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable crane operation works to take place on the A3214 Buckingham Palace Road.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
- (I) entering or proceeding in a southerly direction on Buckingham Palace Road between its junctions with Palace Street and Victoria Street;
  - (2) stopping on Buckingham between its junctions with Bressenden Place and Victoria Street.
     The Order will be effective at certain times between 26th August 2023

and 8th October 2023, every Saturday at  $8:00\,$  AM until Sunday at  $6:00\,$  PM or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as

- shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs. 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
  - any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
     anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police
- constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.

  5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force alternative routes will be indicated by traffic signs. From Buckingham Gate via Palace Street and
- Victoria Street to normal route of travel. From Lower Grosvenor Street via Bressenden Place and Victoria Street to normal route of travel.
