ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 THE A5205 GLA ROAD (ST JOHN'S WOOD ROAD, CITY OF WESTMINSTER) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2023

- I. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable water valve replacement works to take place on the A5205 St John's Wood Road.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from entering St John's Wood Road at its junction with Maida Vale.

The Order will be effective at certain times from $8.00\,\mathrm{AM}$ on the 9th December 2023 until $6.00\,\mathrm{AM}$ on the 11th December 2023 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (I) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- 5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force alternative routes will be indicated by traffic signs. Northbound traffic via Clifton Road, Clifton Gardens, Warwick Avenue, Harrow Road, A501 eastbound on-slip, Marylebone Road and Lisson Grove to normal route of travel. Southbound traffic via Maida Vale southbound, Edgware Road, A501 eastbound on-slip, Marylebone Road and Lisson Grove to normal route of travel.
