ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A200 GLA ROAD (JAMAICA ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF SOUTHWARK) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2024

1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to allow reinforcement of water main works to take place on the A200 Jamaica Road.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
 - (1) entering, exiting, proceeding or stopping on the westbound carriageway of the A200 Jamaica Road between its junctions with Southwark Park Road and Drummond Road. Local access only will be maintained between Lower Road and Southwark Park Road;
 - (2) entering, exiting, proceeding or stopping on Drummond Road between its junctions with Perryn Road and the A200 Jamaica Road.The Order will be effective from 7:00 AM on 26th December 2023 until 7:00 PM on 30th December 2023 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes.
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via for local traffic, Southwark Park Road, Clements Road, Drummond Road, Tranton Road and Keeton's Road to normal route of travel. for thorough traffic via Lower Road, Rotherhithe New Road, Raymouth Road, Southwark Park Road, Grange Road, Tower Bridge Road to normal route of travel.
