  proceeding southwards on the A2 southbound off-slip road from
  Rochester Way Relief Road from turning right into Rochester Way,
  except local buses.
- The road which would be affected by the Order is the A2 GLA Road Rochester Way Relief Road off-slip road to Rochester Way in the Royal Borough of Greenwich.
