connection, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth after consulting Transport for London (TfL) made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily ban vehicles and cyclists from entering Beehive Place for its

entire length. Marshalls will be on site to control access. The ban will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

The Order comes into force on 15 January 2024 and continues for a maximum duration of 3 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that

the works will take place between 15 January 2024 and 17 January 2024, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during that time then the Order may have effect at subsequent times within the maximum period of 3
