## LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14 TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS AND TEMPORARY PARKING, STOPPING AND WAITING RESTRICTIONS - BELVEDERE ROAD IN CONNECTION WITH THE ROYAL FESTIVAL HALL BAFTA AWARDS EVENT

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order, the effect of which would be to temporarily: (1) ban vehicles from entering and waiting including
- waiting for the purpose of loading or unloading in: -(a) Belvedere Road, between the junction of Chicheley Street and Upper Ground
  - Chichelev Street closed between the junctions of Belvedere Road and York Road:
  - (c) Concert Hall Approach between the junctions of Waterloo Road and Belvedere Road:
  - Upper Ground, between the junction of (d) Cornwall Road and Belvedere Road:
  - (e) the slip road linking Waterloo Road with Belvedere Road (the down ramp), (2) Ban left and right turns from York Road into
- Chicheley Street except for access; Close the north-western footway on Belvedere (3)
- Road between Concert Hall Approach and the slip road (linking Waterloo Road with Belvedere Road
- (the down ramp) and direct pedestrians to the opposite footway on Belvedere Road: Suspend all parking places on Belvedere Road between Concert Hall Approach and the slip road
- (linking Waterloo Road with Belvedere Road (the down ramp): 2. The bans are necessary because of the likelihood of danger to the public caused by an increase in pedestrian and vehicular traffic and parked vehicles due to the Bafta
- Awards event taking place at the Royal Festival Hall. 3. The road closures and waiting restrictions would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of traffic signs and vehicles

belonging to residents and businesses of the roads concerned would be allowed access to properties under the direction of marshals. 4. Alternative routes would be available for vehicles

affected by the restrictions referred via York Road. Waterloo Road, Stamford Street, and vice versa

5. The Order would come into force on 15 February 2024
