6 metres outside No. 12 Lower Marsh (Four Corner Café); outside Nos. 27-30 metres Lower Marsh

(2)(Greensmiths); (3)6 metres outside Nos. 32-33 Lower Marsh (Candiero

& Opticalise.):

(4)6 metres outside Nos. 17-18 Lower Marsh (Luca

Othman Hair Associates):

(5) 33 metres outside Nos. 17-21 The Pavement; and, (6) 33 metres opposite Nos. 17-21 The Pavement.

(b) no loading "at any time" restrictions for 33 metres

outside Nos. 17-21 The Pavement.

3. The Order is intended to continue to provide space for

the installation of parklets at the locations specified in

2(a)(1), 2(a)(2), 2(a)(3), 2(a)(5) and a cycle corral in 2(d).
