

## **Licensing Act 2003 Notice of Application**

Take notice that we: S&A Entertainment Ltd have made an application to Lewisham Council acting as the Licensing Authority, for a New Premises Licence in respect of the Taste of the Caribbean Food & Drink Festival at Beckenham Place Park Beckenham Hill Road, London, BR3 1SY.

The details of the application are as follows: a grant of a premises licence to be used on 2 days each year, on the occasion of the Taste of the Caribbean Food & Drink Festival. The event will take place on Saturday 6th and Sunday 7th July 2024, thereafter it will run on a consecutive Saturday and Sunday for one weekend each year between May – September. Sales of Alcohol (for consumption on the premises), 10:00 – 20:00 Saturday, 10:00 – 20:00 Sunday, Recorded music and live music, 10:00 – 20:00 Saturday, 10:00 – 20:00 Sunday.
