ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A205 GLA ROAD (BROWNHILL ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF LEWISHAM) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2024

1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to enable carriageway resurfacing works to take place on the A205 Brownhill Road.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from
 - (1) entering, stopping or proceeding on the A205 Brownhill Road from its junction with Stainton Road to its junction with Ardgowan Road, Local access only will be maintained on Brownhill Road between Plassey Road and Stainton Road and on St Mildreds Road and Brownhill Road between its junctions with Baring Road and Ardgowan Road;
 - (2) entering, stopping, or proceeding on Torridon Road from the extended northern building line of no. 40 Torridon Road to its junction with Arngask Road.

The Order will be effective between 1st April 2024 and 30th September 2024 each night from 9:00 PM until 05:00 AM or until the works has been completed. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force alternative routes will be indicated by traffic signs via (for eastbound traffic) Plassey Road, Sangley Road, Bromley Road, Bromley Hill, London Road, Tweedy Road, College Road, Burnt Ash Lane and Baring Road to normal route of travel. (for westbound traffic) Baring Road, Burnt Ash Lane, Palistow Lane, Cambridge Road, Paxton Lane, College Road, Tweedy Road, Widmore Road, Market Place, High Street, London Road, Bromley Hill, Bromley Road and Rushey Green to normal route of travel.
