

LICENSING ACT 2003

Application has been made by Bird House Brewing Company Limited to the Licensing Authority of London Borough of Southwark to vary the Premises Licence for the Bird House Brewing Company, 41 Arch Unit 1127, Bath Factory Estate, Norwood Road, London, SE24 9AJ. The application is to vary the licence to include: live and recorded music between 1100 and 0000 Sunday to Thursday and 1100 and 0100 Fridays and Saturdays; to extend the hours for the sale of alcohol to 1100 until 0000 Sunday to Thursday and 1100 until 0100 Fridays and Saturdays (consumption on and off the premises) and to permit late night refreshment until 0000 Sunday to Thursday and 0100 Fridays and Saturdays. Also to permit those activities until 0100 on Sundays before a Bank Holiday, Christmas Eve and New Years Eve.
