## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

## THE A5 GLA ROAD (EDGWARE ROAD, CITY OF WESTMINSTER) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

- Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- The purpose of the Order is to enable telecommunications ducting and chamber works to take place on the A5 Edgware Road.
   The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from entering,
  - exiting or proceeding southbound on Edgware Road between its junctions with Crawford Place and Old Marylebone Place;
    The Order will be effective from 7:00 AM on 27th April 2024 until 7:00 PM on 28th April 2024 or until the works has been completed, whichever is sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
  - (I) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
  - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- 5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force alternative routes will be indicated by traffic signs via Sussex Gardens, Westbourne Street, Edgware Road, Chapel Street, Old Marylebone Road to normal route of travel.
