ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 THE A202 GLA ROAD (VAUXHALL BRIDGE ROAD, CITY OF WESTMINSTER) (TEMPORARY BANNED TURN) ORDER 2024

- I. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable water works to take place at A302 Victoria Street.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle except pedal cycles from turning left from Victoria Street into Vauxhall Bridge Road. The Order will be effective at certain times from 8.00 PM on the 27th April 2024 until 5.00 AM on the 29th April 2024 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London
- 5. At such times as the prohibition is in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via Victoria Steet, Grosvenor Gardens, Grosvenor Place, Knightsbridge, Brompton Road, Fulham Road, Edith Grove, Cremorne Road, Cheyne Walk, Chelsea Embankment, Grosvenor Road, and Vauxhall Bridge Road to normal route of travel.
