ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A200 GLA ROAD (CRUCIFIX LANE, LONDON BOROUGH OF SOUTHWARK) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

- Transport for London in consultation with the London Borough of Southwark hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- The purpose of the Order is to enable bridge inspection works to take place on A200 Crucifix Lane.
- The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
 entering, exiting, proceeding, or stopping on Crucifix Lane/Druid Street between its junctions with Tower Bridge Road and Barnham Street. Local access to be maintained.
 - (2) entering, exiting, stopping or proceeding on Barnham Street from its junction with Tooley Street and Crucifix Lane.

The Order will be effective at certain times 2.00 AM on the 20th July 2024 until 11.59PM on the 21st July 2024 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs. The Order will also permit two way operations on Crucifix Lane between its junctions with Shand Street and Barnham Street.

- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (I) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- At such times as the prohibitions are in force alternative routes will be indicated by traffic signs via Tower Bridge Road, Great Dover Street, Borough High Street, Barnham Street, Tooley Street and Shand Street to normal route of travel.
