ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A3212 (GROSVENOR ROAD, CITY OF WESTMINSTER) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER

2024

- I. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable gas main replacement works to take place at the A3212 Grosvenor Road.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle apart from:
 - (I) Except pedl cycles to enter, exit, stop or proceed in a easterly direction on Grosvenor Road between its junctions with Chelsea Bridge/Chelsea Bridge Road and Lupus Street;
 - (2) Enter Lupus Street at its junctions with Grosvenor Road.

The Order will be effective at certain times from 00:01 AM on the 3rd August 2024 until 7:00 PM on the 2nd November 2024, or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to

4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:

time be indicated by traffic signs.

- (I) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes; (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police
- constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- 5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via For buses via Chelsea Bridge Road, Royal

Hospital Road, Chelsea Embankment, Chelsea Bridge, Queenstown Road, Queens Circus, Prince of Wales Drive, Battersea Park Road, Nine Elms Lane, Wandsworth Road, Vauxhall Bridge, Grosvenor Road, Claverton Street to normal direction of travel.
