ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A205 GLA ROAD (WESTHORNE AVENUE/ST MILDRED'S ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF LEWISHAM AND THE ROYAL BOROUGH OF GREENWICH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC, BANNED TURNS AND 20 MPH SPEED RESTRICTION) ORDER 2024

- Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- The purpose of the Order is to enable water connection works to take place at A205 Westhorne Avenue/St Mildred's Road.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
 - (I) turning right from Westhorne Avenue into Alnwick Road;
 - (2) turning right from Alnwick Road into Westhorne Avenue;(3) entering Baring Road at its junction with St Mildred's Road;
 - (4) exceeding 20 M.P.H on Westhorne Avenue/St Mildred's Road between the extended building line of No. 18 St Mildred's Road and the extended building line of No.I Westhorne Avenue.

The Order will be effective at certain times from 7.00 AM on the 11th November 2024 until 7.00 PM on the 10th April 2025 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

Works will be phased such that some restrictions will apply only at certain times.

- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (I) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- 5. At such times as the prohibition is in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs for vehicles travelling in a westerly direction via Baring Road, St Mildred's Road, Sandhurst Road, Hazlebank Road, Whitefoot Lane, Shroffold Road, Northover and Downham Way to normal route of travel. for vehicles travelling in a easterly direction via Baring Road, Westhorne Avenue, Clifftons Roadabout and Westhorne Avenue to the diversion route above. for vehicles travelling from Alnwick Road via Westhorne Avenue, Burnt Ash Hill, Eltham Road, Cliftons Roundabout and Westhorne avenue to normal route of travel. for pedal cycles via Baring Road, Linchmere Road and Helder Grove to normal route of travel.
