## **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

THE A23 GLA MAIN ROAD (LONDON ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF CROYDON) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2025

- 1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above-named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable Thames Water repair works to take place on the A23 London Road.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
  - (I) stopping on the A23 London Road between the extended common boundary of Nos. 848 and 850 London Road and its junction with Colliers Water Lane:
  - (2) entering or exiting the A23 London Road at its junction of the northern arm of the service road fronting Gala Court, No. 795 London Road:
  - (3) turning left from the A23 London Road into the southern arm of the service road fronting Gala Court, No. 795 London Road.

This Order will also allow all vehicles to use the southbound bus lane on the A23 London Road between the extended common boundary of Nos. 848 and 850 London Road and its junction with Colliers Water Lane.

The Order will be effective between 7:00 AM on 13th January 2025 until 7:00 PM on 17th January 2025or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
  - (I) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
  - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
