ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A232 GLA ROAD (EPSOM ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF CROYDON) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF STOPPING AND BANNED TURN) ORDER 2024

1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to enable new electrical cable works to take place on the A232 Epsom Road.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
 - (1) stopping in the Parking and Disabled Persons Vehicles Bay outside of Nos. 152 to 156 Epsom Road;
 - (2) turning left from Stafford Road into Epsom Road.

This Order will also close the north-western footway on Epsom Road between the extended south-western building line of No. 138 Epsom Road and the extended common boundary of Nos. 154 and 156 Epsom Road.

The Order will be effective between 8:00 AM on 4th January 2025 until 4:30 PM on 25th January 2025 or when the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via Stafford Road northbound, Duppas Hill Road, Duppas Hill Lane, Old Town Roundabout, Davenant Road, The Croydon Flyover, Duppas Hill Road and Stafford Road southbound to normal route of travel.
