ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A23 GLA ROAD (BRIXTON ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF STOPPING) ORDER 2024

1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to enable new water connection works to take place on the A23 Brixton Road.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from stopping in the Parking and Disabled Persons Vehicles Bay outside of Nos. 230 to 244 Brixton Road.

This Order will also close the northbound bus lane on Brixton Road between its junction with Ingleton Street and the extended common boundary of Nos. 228a and 230 to 234 Brixton Road.

The Order will be effective between 8:00 AM on 4th January 2025 until 5:00 PM on 5th January 2025 or when the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
