ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A23 GLA MAIN AND SIDE ROAD (STREATHAM HIGH ROAD AND LEWIN ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF STOPPING) ORDER 2025

- I. Transport for London in consultation with the London Borough of Lambeth hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable modernisation of traffic signals to take place on the A23 Streatham High Road.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
 - (1) stopping in the Parking and Disabled Persons Vehicles Bay outside and opposite of Buchanan Lodge, No. 2 Lewin Road;
 - (2) stopping on the A23 Streatham High Road between its junctions with Greyhound Lane and Streatham Common North.

The Order will also will also allow all vehicles to use the northbound bus lane on the A23 Streatham High Road between its junctions with Greyhound Lane and Lewin Road.

The Order will be effective 6:00 AM on 31st March 2025 until 8:00 PM on 20th November 2025 or when the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
