ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A3220 GLA ROAD (WARWICK ROAD, ROYAL BOROUGH OF KENSINGTON AND CHELSEA) (TEMPORARY BANNED TURN) ORDER 2025

- I. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- The purpose of the Order is to enable traffic signal works to take place on Warwick Road.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from turning left from Warwick Road onto A4 West Cromwell Road.

The Order will be effective from I4th April 2025 to 21st April 2025, every night from 8:00 PM to II:59 PM or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- 5. At such times as the prohibition is in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via Warwick Road North-Westbound, Kensington High Street, Warwick Gardens, Pembroke Road, Earl's Court Road. West Cromwell Road Southbound onto normal route of travel.
