The Lewisham (Prescribed Routes) (No.*) Order 202*
Prohibition of Heavy Commercial Vehicles
1. The Council of the London Borough of Lewisham propose to make the above mentioned Order under Section 6 the Road

Traffic Regulation Act 1984 "the Act" (as amended), the effect of which will be to prohibit any heavy commercial vehicle, the maximum gross weight of which exceeds 7.5 tonnes, from entering or proceeding in the lengths of the roads practical in

the maximum gross weight of which exceeds /.3 tonnes, from entering or proceeding in the lengths of the roads specified in Schedule 1 and Schedule 2 to this Notice. The prohibition will not apply in relation to vehicles requiring access to premises or land in or adjacent to the roads mentioned in Schedule 1 and Schedule 2 to this Notice including access for the purposes.

The restriction also does not apply to buses, vehicles used by the emergency services or for the purposes of essential services, works and maintenance, refuse collection, for local authority or agricultural purposes and vehicles proceeding in accordance with directions given by
