

Proposed Changes to On-Street Parking Places Tranquil Vale, SE3

The Lewisham (Free Parking Places, Loading Places and Waiting, Loading and Stopping Restrictions) (Consolidation) (Amendment No *) Order 202* The Lewisham (Charged for Parking Places) (Consolidation) (Amendment No *) Order 202*

1. The Council of the London Borough of Lewisham propose to make under Sections 6, 32, 35, 36, 45, 46 and 49 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) “The Lewisham (Free Parking Places, Loading Places and Waiting, Loading and Stopping Restrictions) (Consolidation) (Amendment No *) Order 202*” and “The Lewisham (Charged for Parking Places) (Consolidation) (Amendment No *) Order 202*” the effect of which will be to:- (a) convert 12m of the existing loading bay fronting Nos. 46-50 Tranquil Vale to paid for on-street parking place (pay by phone), operating Monday to Saturday between 9am and 7pm, maximum stay 2 hours no return within 2 hours (Note: the rest of the loading bay fronting Nos.42-46 Tranquil Vale will remain unchanged); (b) convert 11.5m of the existing paid for on-street parking place (pay by phone) fronting Nos. 29-31 Tranquil Vale to a loading bay at any time (Note: the rest of the paid for on-street parking place fronting Nos.31-35 will remain unchanged).
