ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A23 GLA ROAD (BRIXTON HILL, LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF STOPPING) ORDER 2025

- I. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable drainage investigation works to take place on A23 Brixton Hill.3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from stopping on
- the A23 Brixton Hill between its junctions with Horsford Road and Sudbourne Road.

 The Order will also allow all vehicles to use the northbound bus lane on

the A23 Brixton Hill between its junctions with Horsford Road and Sudbourne Road.

The Order will be effective at certain times between 10:00 PM on 29th April 2025 until 6:00 AM on 30th July 2025 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (I) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
