THE A23 GLA SIDE ROAD (NORFOLK HOUSE ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2025

- AND STOPPING) ORDER 20
- I. Transport for London in consultation with the London Borough of Lambeth hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- The purpose of the Order is to enable works for the installation of pressure reducing valve off 18" water main to take place on Norfolk House Road.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from entering, exiting, proceeding or stopping on Norfolk House Road between its junction with Streatham High Road and the extended western building line of No. 100 Streatham High Road.
 - The Order will be effective between 8:00 AM on 21st April 2025 until 5:00 PM on 2nd May 2025 or when the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- 5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via Mount Ephraim Road and Blakemore Road to normal route of travel, or in reverse.
