ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A232 GLA ROAD (CROYDON ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF BROMLEY) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2025

- I. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable lighting column replacement works to take place at A232 Croydon Road.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from entering, exiting, proceeding, or stopping on Croydon Road between its junctions with Baston Road and Addington Road. Local access will be maintained. The Order will be effective at certain times between the 22nd April 2025 and 21st May 2025 every night from 9.30 PM and 5.00 AM or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall
- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:

from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

- (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
- (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- 5. At such times as the prohibition is in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via Baston Road, Pickhurst Lane, Station Approach, Bourne Way and Addington Road or reverse to normal route of travel.
