ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A301 GLA ROAD (WATERLOO BRIDGE AND LANCASTER PLACE, CITY OF WESTMINSTER AND LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

- I. Transport for London in consultation with the City of Westminster and London Borough of Lambeth hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable replacement expansion joint works to take place on A301 Waterloo Bridge.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
 - (I) entering, exiting or proceeding on the northbound carriageway of the A301 Waterloo Bridge/Lancaster Place between its junctions with the circulatory traffic system at the junctions of Belvedere Road, Stamford Street, Waterloo Road, Tenison Way York Road and Waterloo Bridge hereafter referred to as Waterloo Roundabout and Strand;
 - (2) entering, exiting or proceeding on the southbound carriageway of the A301 Waterloo Bridge/Lancaster Place between its junctions with Strand and Waterloo Roundabout.
 - Access will be maintained to the unnamed roads connecting the Waterloo Bridge with Belvedere Road
 - Works will be phased such that some restrictions will apply only at certain times.
 - The Order will be effective at certain times between 9th May 2025 and 2nd December 2025, each night, Friday to Monday from 10:00 PM until 6:00 AM (the works will cease at 6:00 AM each Monday morning) or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (I) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- 5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs for via Stamford Street, Blackfriars Road, Blackfriars Bridge, New Bridge Street, Fleet Street, Strand, Aldwych and Strand or in reverse to normal route of travel.
