ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A102 GLA ROAD (BLACKWALL TUNNEL APPROACH ROYAL BOROUGH OF GREENWICH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to enable rail bridge inspection works to take place at A102 Blackwall Tunnel Approach.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from entering or proceeding on the:
 - (1) un-named on slip road connecting Woolwich Road/Horn Lane with the South-eastbound carriageway of Blackwell Tunnel Southern Approach;
 - (2) un-named off slip road connecting the north-westbound carriageway of Blackwell Tunnel Northern Approach to Woolwich Road.

The Order will be effective at certain times between the 5th May 2025 and the 7th May 2025 every night from 10.00 PM and 5.00 AM or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
5. At such times as the prohibition is in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs for traffic travelling in a northerly direction via Blackwell Tunnel Northern Approach, Blackwell Lane and Woolwich Road to normal route of travel. for traffic travelling in a southerly direction via Woolwich Road, Woolwich Church Street, John Wilson Street, Grand Depot Road, Academy Road and Shooters Hill Road to normal route of travel.
