## **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

## THE A3213 GLA SIDE ROAD (BRIDGE PLACE, CITY OF WESTMINSTER) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2025

- I. Transport for London in consultation with the City of Westminster hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2.The purpose of the Order is to enable carriageway repair works to take place on the A3213 GLA Side Road Bridge Place.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from entering, exiting, proceeding or stopping on Bridge Place between its junction with Eccleston Bridge and the extended western building line of No. 6 Bridge Place:

Local access will be maintained.

The Order will be effective at certain times from 7:00 PM on 20th May 2025 until 7:00 PM on 22nd May 2025 or when the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
  - (I) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
  - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- 5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via Wilton Road, Gillingham Street, Ecclestone Bridge to normal route of travel OR Wilton Road. Victoria Street, Buckingham Palace Road to normal route of travel.
