ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE GLA ROADS AND GLA SIDE ROADS (WESTMINSTER) RED ROUTE CONSOLIDATION TRAFFIC ORDER 2008 A5 GLA ROAD (EDGWARE ROAD) VARIATION ORDER 2025

1. Transport for London, hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Order under section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
2. The general nature and effect of the Order will be to:
 - 1) convert the existing Disabled Persons Vehicle bay into a Loading and Unloading and Disabled Persons Vehicle Bay Edgware Road, opposite Crawford Place operating Mon-Sat 7am-7pm except loading 20 minutes or Disabled Persons Vehicles to park for a maximum of 3 hours;
 - 2) reduce the length of the Borough controlled bay opposite Nos. 178 to 174 Edgware Road by 24.5 metres at its south-eastern end;
 - 3) relocate the existing 8.6 metre Loading and Unloading bay opposite Nos. 168 to 176 Edgware Road to opposite 182 to 184 Edgware Road, operating, Mon-Sat No Stopping 7am-7pm loading 20 minutes;
 - 4) introduce 27 metres Double Red Lines opposite Nos. 168 to 180 Edgware Road operating, No Stopping At Any Time.
3. The road which would be affected by the Order is the A5 GLA Road – Edgware Road in the City of Westminster.
4.
